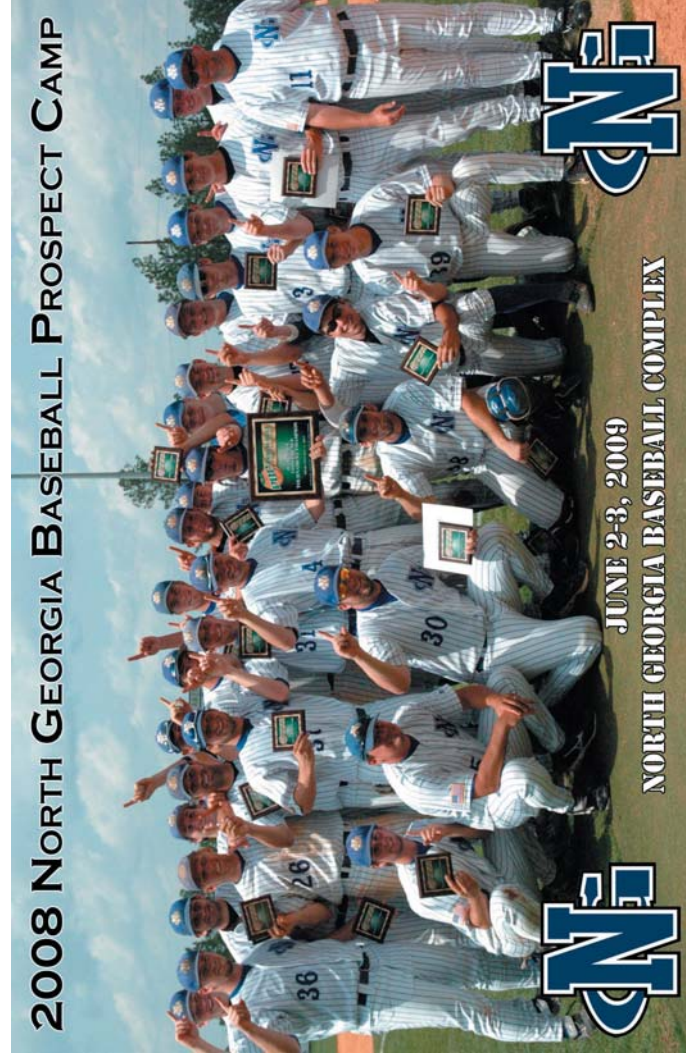

TOM CANTRELL, DIRECTOR



Coach Tom Cantrell is in his ninth season as head coach of the North Georgia Saints. In 2007, Cantrell's team finished with a record of 34-22. Coach Cantrell was the 2007 Peach Belt Conference Coach of the Year, and in 2008 the Saints received their first ever NCAA National Ranking coming in at #21 in the preseason polls. In 1985, Coach Cantrell played for Dekalb Community College. He signed with the Atlanta Braves and was sent to Pulaski, Virginia where he hit .301, made the All-Star Team, and helped the team win the Appalachian League World Series. In 1987, he retired from professional ball and began coaching.

Cantrell was born in Habersham, Georgia. He was a two-time All-State shortstop at North Clayton High School and during his sophomore season he hit .362 and was named to the All-Region Team. He will be joined by assistant coach Derrick Tucker, as well as the North Georgia baseball team during the 2008 camp.

Each camp is limited to the first 150 applicants. Campers will be divided into teams for daily instruction and games. Camp instruction, drills and games will take place in Memorial Hall on the beautiful North Georgia College & State University campus in Dahlonega. Campers will receive individual instruction in morning sessions and play games to showcase skills during afternoon sessions.

All Campers need: Tennis and baseball shoes, white socks, athletic supporter, bat & glove, baseball hat & pants, t-shirt & shorts, cooler (optional). Campers are encouraged to bring their own lunch as they will have a one hour break in between sessions.
