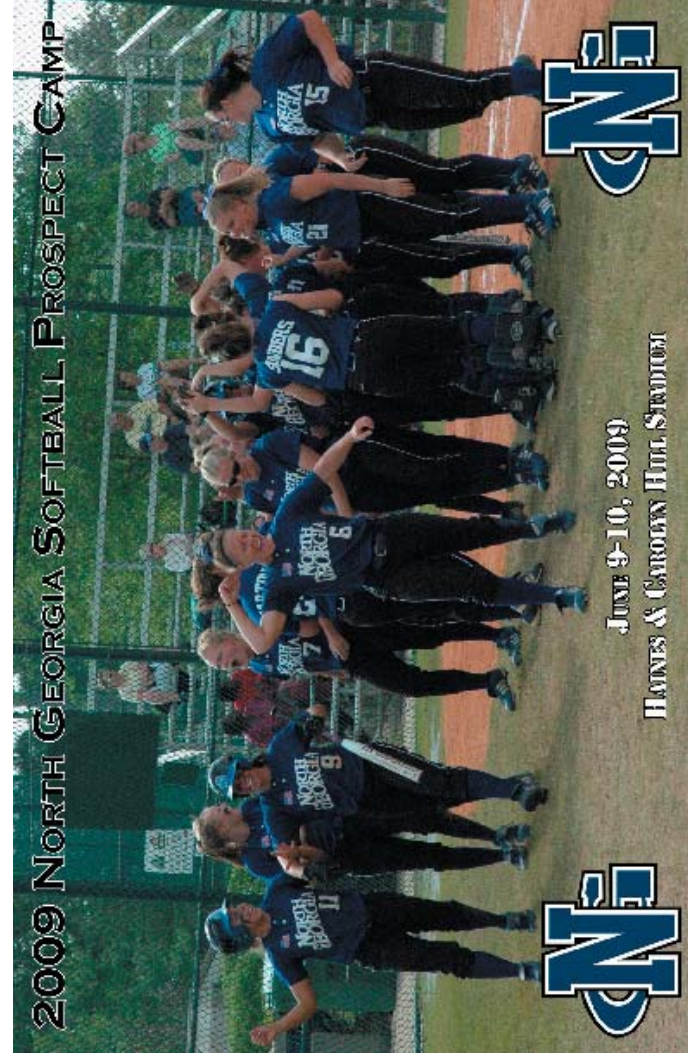

## MIKE DAVENPORT, DIRECTOR



Mike Davenport is in his ninth season as Head Softball Coach of the Saints Softball Program with an overall record of 338-133. He has been a familiar name to the NGCSU family where he begins his 13th year in the Athletic Department.

While at North Georgia, he has been part of seven conference titles and five National Tournament (NAIA) appearances. In 2008 Davenport led the North Georgia Softball Program to a 38-15 record overall and 10-8 record in the Peach Belt Conference. Davenport's team had a second place finish in the PBC tournament, while finishing second at the South Atlantic Regional Tournament.

Mike Davenport received the degree of Bachelor of Science in Recreation from the University of Florida in 1994, and received his M.Ed. in Physical Education from NGCSU in 1998.

Prospect camp is open to any high school player with a graduation date of 2010, 2011, or 2012 and any Ju-Co athletes who have the aspirations to play at the next level. This camp will provide players with fundamentals they will take with them for years to come, while also helping players be seen by college coaches.

### Directions to Field

From Atlanta: Take 85N to GA 400N. Turn left on GA HWY 60, proceed to first red light (Morrison Moore Parkway) - turn left at light onto bypass. At the next red light turn left onto Barlow Road and Hill Stadium will be located on your left.

### ALL PROSPECT CAMPERS

Fee: \$150.00

\$50 non-refundable deposit holds your space. Balance due two weeks before camp begins.

**Each camp is limited to the first 150 applicants.** Campers will be divided into teams for daily instruction and games. Camp instruction, drills and games will take place at the Saints Softball Complex on the beautiful North Georgia College & State University campus in Dahlonega. Campers will receive individual instruction in morning sessions and play games to showcase skills during afternoon sessions. All Campers need: tennis shoes and cleats/turfs, socks, bat & glove, softball hat & pants, t-shirt & shorts, cooler (optional).
