Mandatory Meetings	The team captain (or team representative) MUST attend the preseason captain's meeting for each sport. Teams that fail to have a representative attend the meeting will be dropped from the league.

New Intramural Policies (See Intramural Handbook for Additional Information)

Pool Play	Teams with a .500 winning average or higher will automatically advance to pool play; however, teams below .500 may request to be entered into pool play.
All-Campus Championship	The top 2 teams from each division, winners of each pool, and a wild card team will advance to the All-Campus Championship for major sports.
Play-Off Draw Meeting	There will be a play-off draw meeting to seed teams in the All-Campus Championship. Team representatives will draw numbers and place themselves in the bracket. Teams not in attendance will be placed by the IM Director.
Intramural Points	Teams may receive up to 15 additional Intramural Standing Points by contributing officials to the Intramural Program. Teams will receive points based on participation and skill.
