RATIONALE FOR JUDGMENT OF COMPLIANCE

In the University System of Georgia, all fund-raising activities are organized under the umbrella of "cooperative organizations" and the regulations governing these organizations are laid out in the Board of Regents Policy Manual, Section 1905 [1].

The North Georgia College & State University Foundation, Inc. is a cooperative organization, and the relationship is defined in a Memorandum of Agreement [2]. At NGCSU, fund-raising activities conducted on behalf of the University are authorized by the Office of the President and governed by the Vice President of Institutional Advancement per the NGCSU Fund Raising Policy [3].

As defined in the Statutes [4, p. 3] of North Georgia College & State University (Article II), the President of NGCSU is the chief executive officer of the University and all of its departments and exercises such supervision and direction as to promote the efficient operation of the institution. The President has jurisdiction over the formulation and organization of bylaws and operating policies of all departments, divisions, colleges, and administrative offices of the University. The President is responsible to the Chancellor for the operation and management of the institution and for the execution of all directives of the Board and the Chancellor.
